

## Katz Family

Four years ago, in the month of Tammuz, our dear husband and father Mordechai David - Marcos - Katz passed away.

Marcos was a man of unity. He grew up in a family of Bobov chassidim in Krakow, Poland, and was himself a descendant of the Rebbe's family - a great-grandson of Rebbe Chaim of Sanz. He was an ardent Zionist who devotedly supported the State of Israel and unflaggingly stepped up to strengthen and sustain it.

Marcos was first and foremost an educator but he was also a businessman and an industrialist, a philanthropist and an influential donor. Torah and Judaism were the pillars of his personality. That is why he chose to commemorate the memory of his mother with a prize that characterized his great spirit.
