### **Qualification aim**

To guide and assess development of knowledge, understanding and skills in management and advanced practice within health and social care and children and young people's services. This qualification confirms competence in these areas and serves as the required qualification for registration and regulatory requirements in the sector where appropriate in England. Units can also be used for CPD.

### **Who is this qualification suitable for?**

The management pathways are suitable for assistant managers and deputy managers working in day or domiciliary services who are looking to progress their career. They are also appropriate for managers who have not yet achieved a vocational qualification at this level.

The residential services pathways are aimed at those in similar job roles as those taking the management pathway but offer a focus on management and care in residential settings.

The Advanced Practice pathways are suitable for senior practitioners who would like to develop their career but wish to remain active practitioners within the management framework.

### **What is involved?**

Choose one of six pathways, tailoring the qualification to your job role:

- Management of Adult Services
- Management of Adult Residential Services
- Advanced Practice in Adult Services
- Management of Children and Young People's Services
- Management of Children and Young People's Residential Services
- Advanced Practice in Children and Young People's Services
