3	Create a PSU Student Account: http://www.pdx.edu/admissions/other-applicant	By the end of August
4	Pay PSU Student Account Set-up fee (<i>only once</i>)	By the end of August
5	Send ICI your new PSU Student Account Identification number: elsaw@intercultural.org	By the end of August
6	Pay PSU the class tuition. You will be invoiced.	By Dec. 1

3. How do I get my grade?

We will provide you with guidelines for requesting your transcript from PSU in December.

4. Can I transfer these credits to other programs?

This is the decision of your college or university. MAIR students can use SIIC courses as electives.

5. Can I request an extension on the assignments deadlines?

Unfortunately, we cannot give extensions. If you cannot commit to the assignment deadlines, please do not register.

6. Can I get a refund if I change my mind?

ICI is happy to return your check for the Academic Grading fee if you decide to withdraw before September 12. PSU's Student Account fee is not refundable. PSU's tuition is partially refundable and the process is complex. We'll refer you to the appropriate PSU administrator if needed.
