### Spiritual Life Retreat January 24<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>

A Spiritual Life Retreat will be held at the Second Baptist Church on Friday evening, January 24<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, January 25<sup>th</sup>. The purpose of the retreat is to explore different spiritual practices which may be helpful in enhancing one's personal spiritual life. We will be joined by our friends from the First Congregational Church and the Enfield American Baptist Church.

The retreat, which was originally scheduled for last October, begins on Friday evening at 5:00 pm with a potluck supper and conversation in the Fellowship Hall followed by a brief time of worship and our first spiritual practice – Lectio Divina (a Latin term which means "Divine reading" or "Sacred reading," of biblical texts). We will conclude by 8:00.

On Saturday, we will gather in the Fellowship Hall at 9:00 am and there will be different spiritual practices to discover and choose from in four separate session throughout the day. In the morning, there are two sessions - from 9:30 – 10:30 and 10:45 -11:45. During these sessions, you have a choice between Yoga, the Examen (a spiritual practice of discernment and prayer), Qi Gong, and, Walking the Labyrinth (which will be available throughout the day). Following lunch, which will be provided, there are different spiritual practices during two separate sessions: Journaling, Guided Meditation, Reflective Walking outside (weather permitting) and making Prayer Beads. Closing reflections and worship will conclude at 4:00 pm.

We need to know how many will be coming to prepare for lunch on Saturday and to have enough supplies for several of the spiritual practices so **please rsvp** to the church office – office@secondbaptistsuffield.org, or via phone – 860-668-1661. Cost is \$10 per person or \$25 per family. If you are unable to attend the entire retreat, please feel free to participate in those practices that your schedule permits – and please let us know.
