



"Being One: Sermons on the Gospel of John"

Following the Revised Common Lectionary, I will be preaching from the Gospel of John in May. We prepare for a new chapter in this church's history, and it is imperative that the church be one, one with Jesus and one with each other in love. You might want to keep this schedule below handy so that you can read the scripture prior to the sermon.

May 1 Third Sunday of Easter/ Earth Sunday (Communion Sunday): John 21:1-19, "Do You Love Me?"

May 8 Fourth Sunday of Easter: John 10:22-30 (Mother's Day): "The Father and I Are One"

May 15 Fifth Sunday of Easter: John 13:31-35: "Love One Another"

May 22 Sixth Sunday of Easter: John 14:23-29: "Do Not Let Your Hearts Be Troubled"

May 29 Seventh Sunday of Easter (Memorial Day Sunday): John 17:20-26, "That They May All Be One."

Deacons and Worship

Some questions we will ponder include: What is worship? Why do we worship? What are some strengths of SBC worship? What are some weaknesses? What do you want to remain the same? I am currently writing a book with my former student Dr. Mitzi J. Smith, who is the J. Davison Philips Professor of New Testament at Columbia Theological Seminary in Decatur, GA. Our book is tentatively entitled *Testimonies and the Testifying Bible: Disruptive and Creative Interpretations*. We approach the New Testament as a collection of testimonies. The authors write out of their own experiences with God in Jesus through the Spirit. We have a contract with Cascade Books of Eugene, OR for a deadline of June 30. Pray for us that we make it.

Candidate Sunday April 24th

The Pastoral Search Committee is pleased to share with you all that we have identified a candidate to be our next settled pastor. He is passionate, dynamic, and highly qualified and we are excited to announce that he will be coming to SBC on Sunday, April 24th to preach and to meet everyone.

Our By-Laws of Second Baptist Church state "the pastor shall be elected by ballot at a special meeting called for the purpose, of which public notice shall have been given from the pulpit or in the calendar on the two Sundays immediately preceding the date of the meeting."

In addition to the announcements from the pulpit, this message is our notice to you that we will be holding a vote on Sunday, April 24, 2022. After our Pastor Candidate has preached, we will vote by ballot to affirm him as our next pastor of Second Baptist Church of Suffield and Honorary Pastor of the Historical First Baptist Church of Suffield.

On Sunday, April 24th, the Search Committee will host a continental breakfast at 8:15 in Fellowship Hall so that you may have an opportunity to meet the candidate prior to the service.

The pastor will lead us in worship, and at the conclusion of the service, he will be excused to wait in the Parlor while the Congressional Vote is held. Following the vote, the Search Committee and church leadership are invited to meet in the Parlor to extend the call to the pastor.

A reception will follow in Fellowship Hall for all.

An installation date will be forthcoming, following the affirmative vote and acceptance of the call.

The search committee wishes to extend our thanks for your prayers and support as we have moved through this process.





The Second Baptist Church of Suffield is a community of faith whose members strive to identify and help those in need. The members of the

Missions ministry are grateful that through the generosity of our congregants, we have been able to support many local and international organizations throughout the year.

For the month of May, the Missions ministry has chosen Camp Wightman to be the beneficiary of your generosity. Our contributions will pay ½ the weekly tuition for SBC children who choose to attend camp this summer. The 2022 tuition is \$650/week per child. Any additional balance will be used to offset operational and materials cost for the camp.

The purpose of Camp Wightman is to enable youth and adults of the American Baptist Churches of Connecticut and others in:

- Establishing their relationship with God and understanding of Jesus Christ
- Growing in responsible maturity through the application of Christian principles
- Knowing the enjoyment of Christian community Showing Christ's love for one another

Camp Wightman affords each participant the opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of themselves and their relationship to God and others. When camp counselors are asked about what they love 'best' about Camp Wightman, they reply:

"At Camp Wightman, we have two "best" parts! One is the time you get to spend learning about God and exploring our theme for the summer – this is the reason we do camp and so we make an extra effort to make these times fun and meaningful for you. The other "best" part is friendship – making friends, being with friends, and having fun with friends. At Wightman you get to know each other on the inside, not based on what you look like on the outside. Your Wightman friends can last a lifetime."
