NURSERY PROCEDURES

The nursery is a service provided to the parents and care-givers of the children of Second Baptist Church. We are committed to providing the highest quality care possible for your children. In order to achieve this high standard of care for each child, we want you to be informed of our operational policies.

- Parents/guardians need to fill out an information card for each newborn or walker that is brought to the nursery. Give the card to the nursery caregivers. Update the needed information on your child as their needs change.
- The nursery room and cribs are cleaned and disinfected after each use.
- We disinfect all toys after use, in order to ensure that our nursery is clean and safe for your child.
- We operate a well-baby nursery, so please make sure your child is well. For the protection of all the children in our care, we cannot accept a child who has been vomiting, has a cold, the flu, a fever, rash, runny nose, persistent cough, diarrhea, or any other signs of illness. We request that you not put your child in the nursery while they are at risk of exposing other children, for 24 hours after having any of the above symptoms. Thank you for helping us keep our nursery a healthy place for all.
- Nursery staff uses disposable gloves for diapering each child and hands are washed with anti-bacterial soap and warm water after each child has been changed.
- When a baby is placed in the nursery. Only the parent will be able to pick up the child.



Our infant and toddler nursery provides parents with the choice of taking their young ones with them into the worship service or having them cared for during any part or all of the service.

Check in and check out

A greeter will welcome you and your baby. Please fill out the sign-in sheet and take a pager. Write the pager number down on the sign-in sheet. Please put the pager next to your body, as it will vibrate silently if you are needed to return to the nursery. After the service, please come promptly to pick up your child. You will need to sign them out and return the pager in order to pick up your child.

Nursery is provided for birth through age 3 during the service. Even while your children are still infants, they know the love and acceptance given them by their church family. From infants being rocked to toddlers listening to songs about Jesus, this is definitely the place to be ... this is a fun place ... this is Church.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Plastic bottles or a spill-proof cup
- At least two disposable diapers,
- Wipes
- Change of clothes
- Pacifier / comfort item.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. During the services the nursery staff may provide water and a cracker snack to the children. Please let us know if your child can or cannot participate. We will serve fluids that you provide in a bottle or sippy cup, or we will provide water. If your child has a food allergy, please inform the nursery greeter when you sign in your child.

2. The parents/guardians of babies who are crying and cannot be consoled after 15 minutes will be contacted.

3. Please label all belongings with the child's name.

4. It is our hope that Parents/guardians who regularly use our nursery services will be willing to serve in the nursery ministry. Please contact us for help getting started.

5. Please be prompt at picking up your children at the close of each service.
