### Carr's Comments

Though I write these words two weeks before Christmas, the new year is nearly upon us, and with it, the possibility of many new ministries, relationships and ways forward for us to engage with one another in God's work for the world

God so loves. I have always taken seriously the words of the prophet Isaiah, "Behold, I am about to do a new thing," because "new things" are always being born through God, in this world of God's. Our question is, "do we have the eyes to see them?"

One of those new things is the partnership of mutually enhancing ministry we are establishing with the Enfield American Baptist Church (EABC) which will be celebrating their final worship service at the end of December after 55 years as a congregation. I have proposed to share leadership with EABC's pastor, the Reverend Dr. Rachael Lawrence, after the first of the year (please see Rachael's bio in another part of the Crier). I served as Rachael's mentor during the ordination process and Rachael's ordination service was held in our sanctuary this September. To meet this end, I will reduce my workload and salary/benefits to ¾ (.75) time in order to create a ¼ (.25) time position for Rachael. The position descriptions have been reviewed and approved by the SBC Church Staff Relations Committee, the Diaconate and the Council of Ministries. At the Congregational Meeting called for December 29<sup>th</sup>, the congregation will discuss and, hopefully, vote to accept this new relationship (please see another part of the Crier for the announcement of this meeting that was first posted on November 29<sup>th</sup>). As part of the proposal, EABC and Second Baptist Church (SBC) will remain separate legal entities for at least the first six months following this joint venture to provide time to discern what needs to happen with the EABC church site and any other legal matters.

Please keep our congregations in your prayers and in your heart so that, together, we might open the eyes of our hearts to see what God is doing in the world, recognizing our individual and collective calling to be faithful to whatever God may be moving us to do, and actively engage in the work for the sake of God's "kingdom on Earth as it is in heaven."

## Spiritual Life Retreat January 24<sup>th</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>

A Spiritual Life Retreat will be held at the Second Baptist Church on Friday evening, January 24<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, January 25<sup>th</sup>. The purpose of the retreat is to explore different spiritual practices which may be helpful in enhancing one's personal spiritual life. We will be joined by our friends from the First Congregational Church and the Enfield American Baptist Church.

The retreat, which was originally scheduled for last October, begins on Friday evening at 5:00 pm with a potluck supper and conversation in the Fellowship Hall followed by a brief time of worship and our first spiritual practice – Lectio Divina (a Latin term which means "Divine reading" or "Sacred reading," of biblical texts). We will conclude by 8:00.

On Saturday, we will gather in the Fellowship Hall at 9:00 am and there will be different spiritual practices to discover and choose from in four separate sessions throughout the day. In the morning, there are two sessions - from 9:30 – 10:30 and 10:45 -11:45. During these sessions, you have a choice between Yoga, the Examen (a spiritual practice of discernment and prayer), Qi Gong, and, Walking the Labyrinth (which will be available throughout the day). Following lunch, which will be provided, there are different spiritual practices during two separate sessions: Journaling, Guided Meditation, Reflective Walking outside (weather permitting) and making Prayer Beads. Closing reflections and worship will conclude at 4:00 pm.

We need to know how many will be coming to prepare for lunch on Saturday and to have enough supplies for several of the spiritual practices so **please RSVP** to the church office – [office@secondbaptistsuffield.org](mailto:office@secondbaptistsuffield.org), or via phone – 860-668-1661. Cost is \$10 per person or \$25 per family. If you are unable to attend the entire retreat, please feel free to participate in those practices that your schedule permits – and please let us know.

## Special Congregational Meeting Sunday, December 29<sup>th</sup>

A special congregational meeting of the Second Baptist Church of Suffield is being called for on Sunday, December 29<sup>th</sup> immediately following morning worship at 10:00 am in the Sanctuary.

The purpose of the meeting is to consider and act on two matters. One, to welcome and affirm the members and friends of the Enfield American Baptist Church (EABC) into mutual ministry with our congregation beginning Sunday, January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020. After 55 years as a congregation, EABC will hold their final worship service on Christmas Eve, 2019 at 5:00 pm and a “celebration of ministry” on December 29<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am. At this time, the Reverend Dr. Rachael Lawrence pastor of the EABC will formally conclude. EABC and Second Baptist Church (SBC) will remain separate legal entities for at least the first six months following this joint venture to provide time to discern what needs to happen with the EABC church site and any other legal matters.

The second matter relates to the pastoral ministry of SBC and EABC. The general position descriptions are detailed below (this is in process):

The key way we intend to finance this ministry is through dedicating a portion of Rev. Carr’s current salary and benefits package to pay Rev. Dr. Lawrence for a .25 FTE position. The Finance Committee of SBC will be proposing specific financial packages for both Carr and Lawrence.

At the December 29<sup>th</sup> meeting, the congregation will be invited to ask questions, discuss and vote on these two items. Please make every effort to attend this important congregational meeting.

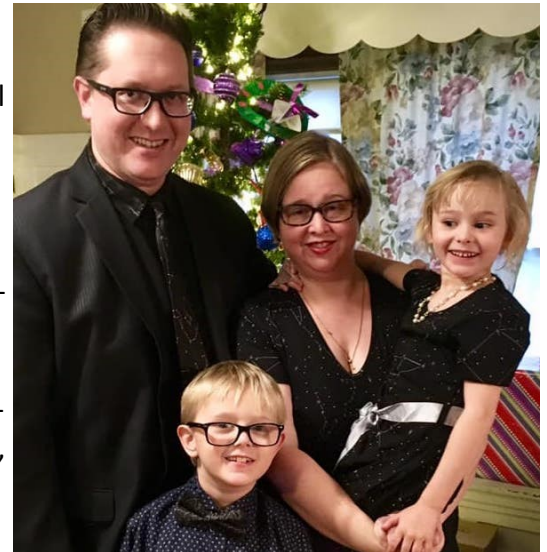
## Meet the Reverend Dr. Rachael Lawrence

The Reverend Dr. Rachael Lawrence has served as transitional pastor for Enfield American Baptist Church in Connecticut from 2016-2019. She was ordained to the pastoral ministry in the American Baptist Churches USA in 2019. A multi-vocational pastor, she is Assistant Director for the Center for Educational Policy at the University of Massachusetts Amherst, as well as a classical singer. Her PhD in Educational Policy and Leadership is from the University of Massachusetts Amherst. She holds a Master of Music (University of Akron) and a Bachelor of Music (Heidelberg University). She completed a Certificate in Theology and Ministry from Princeton Theological Seminary.

The American Baptist Home Mission Societies invited her to participate in the Co-Creators Incubator. With ABHMS support, she is

developing a music and movement based worship series for young children and their caretakers. In 2019, she founded KinderSpirit Inc, a non-profit with the goal of developing curricula to support positive spiritual development through meeting the needs of children, as well as community members with special needs, in worship settings.

Before her current work in pastoral ministry and educational research/evaluation, Rachael was a K-12 music teacher. She served in title 1 schools on the *Sicangu Lakota Oyate* (Rosebud Indian Reservation) and Troy (NY) city schools. Prior to this, she was an adjunct professor at the University of Akron (OH), where she taught applied voice lessons and music theory. During this time, she served as a music minister for the Firestone Park Disciples of Christ Church in Akron, OH and as a youth ministry intern for the Goodyear Heights United Church of Christ. In addition, she was a professional chorister for the Congregation *Anshe Emeth Beth Tefilo* (The Park Synagogue) in Cleveland Heights, OH.
