# Crier April 2022 From the Interim Pastor: Another Crier (Weeper?)

It is my pleasure to serve you as interim pastor. I began February 20, and so this is the first *Crier article I have had the pleasure to write. I see that the scripture basis for the newsletter title is Isaiah 40:3: "A voice cries out in the wilderness, 'Prepare the way of the Lord!'" Questions come to mind: In what ways are we a voice? In what ways do we have a voice? In what ways is this newsletter a voice? In what other ways do we cry out? I think of the town crier. Wikipedia has an interesting article on town crier: "All through the American Colonies and beyond, [places] such as Santa Fe, New Mexico; Boston, Massachusetts and Stamford, Connecticut had criers during the mid-17th century." The Cambridge Dictionary associates a town crier with a storyteller, and storytelling is making a comeback in the digital age.* 

Questions continue to come to mind with this verse: In what ways are we in a wilderness—with COVID, with the transition, with Lent, with war in Ukraine and elsewhere? How are we to prepare the way of the Lord? What Lord? Jesus, God, Vishnu? Isaiah certainly meant the Lord God of Israel, but does the verse still mean that? Vishnu, incidentally, is a Hindu god, but what responsibilities do we have in 2022 for interfaith dialogue? Inquiring minds want to know!

"Omigosh! I hope that we are not going to hear more of this nonsense from the pulpit," you think. Come and

March 27 "Prodigal" (Luke 15:1-3, 11b-32)

April 3 (Communion) "Anointed for Burial" (John 12:1-8)


April 10 (Palm Sunday) "Heavenly Peace & Highest Heavenly Glory!" (Luke 19:28-40)




# **Volunteer Opportunity**



# One Great Hour of Sharing Ukraine Relief

Immediately after the Russian invasion of Ukraine, International Ministries (of ABC-USA) released an initial grant in One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS) emergency relief to the European Baptist Federation to provide humanitarian aid for Ukrainian Baptists. This grant joined a larger, global Baptist response to this evolving situation. Since then, additional monies have become available to provide continuing support to the Baptist Union of Ukraine as they provide evacuation and humanitarian aid to people coming through or trapped in Western Ukraine. Additionally, IM missionaries in Hungary (Amanda and Jon Good, Carmella Jones, and Becky and Larry Stanton) are directly engaged in helping to provide relief for Ukrainian refugees coming into Hungary.

Members of the Missions Ministry at Second Baptist have authorized to immediately send \$1500 to OGHS to help in this effort. During the month of April, we are asking the congregation to help support our neighbors in Ukraine by giving generously. If paying by check please designate in the memo line to "OGHS – Ukraine Relief". If donating electronically go to the "Online Giving" link on the church website: www.secondbaptistsuffield.org and select "Communion Offering".

Financial funding is desperately needed to continue the ministries and humanitarian aid in this area. However, prayer is paramount. Please pray for the region and those serving God and their neighbors.
