Welcome Reverend Dr. Michael Newheart

Reverend Dr. Michael Newheart, our Interim Pastor, began his ministry with us on February 20, 2022. He comes to Second Baptist after completing his service as Sr. Bridge/Interim Pastor at West Hartford's First Church of Christ Congregational. Prior to that, he served as Interim/Transitional Pastor in Madison, Wisconsin, Shawnee Mission, KS and St. Joseph, MO. In other ministerial roles, Dr. Newheart has served as a Youth Minister as well as several stints as an Associate Pastor.

After earning both his MDiv (1981) and PhD (1985) from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, KY, the latter in New Testament Language and Literature, Dr. Newheart joined the faculty at Howard University School of Divinity in Washington, DC. An Assistant Professor of New Testament Language and Literature in 1991, he rose to the rank of full Professor in 2005 and since 2017 has been Professor Emeritus. Three books and numerous articles have been published as a result of his research. His books include, My Name is Legion: The Story and Soul of the Gerasene Demoniac as well as Word and Soul: A Psychological, Literary, and Cultural Reading of the Fourth Gospel. Dr. Newheart has also contributed a wellregarded chapter in a book about Glen Stassen titled, Ethics as if Jesus Mattered.



HOUSE RULES Now, with significant Covid Cases in Suffield

If you are not feeling well, Please Call, Join Remotely or Wait until you are feeling better.

When to keep your mask on:

<u>If</u> you are not fully vaccinated; <u>If</u> you are singing; <u>If</u> you were recently in contact with someone that contracted Covid; <u>If</u> you are immune compromised.

When to lower your mask:

If you are only with those in your 'pod' and none require a mask per guidelines above; If you have checked with all those around you and they are comfortable with your lowering mask.

Please keep 6 feet social distancing unless with your 'pod'.

Missions News

Most of you are aware that the Missions Committee routinely provides financial support to organizations affiliated with Baptist ministries, as well as to local, national, and world-wide concerns. While we are pleased that we have the means to be able to write checks to assist these groups, our members have been considering how best to become actively involved in helping our local and regional neighbors in need.

In this endeavor, the Missions Committee is very excited about our most recent project, which was proposed by committee member Barbara Lawrence. We have purchased 100 yoga mats for distribution to the Enfield Warming Center, the Springfield Rescue Mission, and the Friends of the Homeless. Each of these organizations expressed great interest in the mats as a donation for homeless persons. The mats are ½ in thick, water resistant, and can be rolled up and secured with a carry strap for easy transport. Each mat is printed with telephone numbers for The National Coalition Against Domestic Violence, The National Call Center for Homeless Veterans, and The National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. If the mats are well received, we will make additional purchases if needed and, hopefully, widen our distribution.

Our committee is continuing to think about new opportunities to offer assistance to our community at large, and we will keep you informed about our future activities!
