

On December 10-December 11, 2021 dozens of severe tornados caused significant damage and tragic loss of lives in six Central/Mid-West states - Arkansas, Mississippi, Missouri, Kentucky, Tennessee and Illinois.

On behalf of American Baptist Churches USA, American Baptist Home Mission Societies (ABHMS) recently released monies in One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS) disaster-relief funds.
