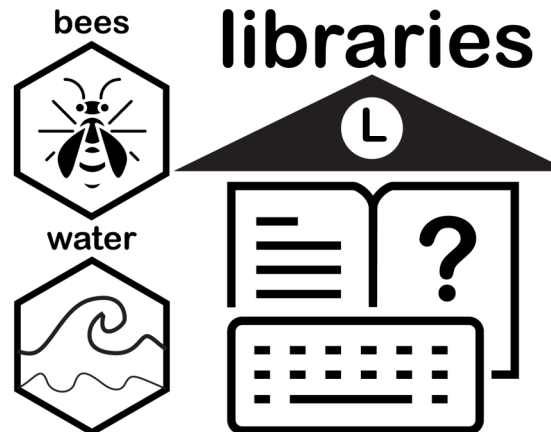
This run walk is not only a long-standing Lodi tradition, it's also a much needed fundraiser for our Lodi Public Library.

- Local government funds for the library have shown very little or even no increase for more than two decades.

Each year the technology, supplies, building maintenance, and payroll costs increase, but governmental funding for the library hasn't kept pace.
