Karen Village Trip

DAY I

- 08.00 A.M. Pick up from your accommodation. Then depart for the ***Sai Yok Noi Waterfall.***
- 10.00 A.M. Visit the ***Hellfire Pass*** memorial museum to see the original railroad from the WWII.
- 12.00 A.M. Time for lunch at the good local restaurant.
- 12.00 P.M. Depart for the mineral ***hot water (Hin Dad Hot Spring)*** to relax your body and for good health.
- 02.00 P.M. Visit ***“Nong Bang Village”*** or Karen village to get close to Karen villagers and their lives and then start trekking by 4x4 WD truck through the bamboo jungle, then trekking for 4-5 hours through bamboo forest and lush jungle amidst fresh atmosphere close to natural stream.
- 07.00 P.M. Time for ***Thai cooking*** course and dinner, which is cooked by guide or you, can try by yourself. Enjoy seeing ***Karen guitar during dinner.***
- 08.30 P.M. Stay ***overnight in the bamboo hut*** with the sleeping bag in the jungle. ***(simple staying & no electricity!!!!)***

DAY II

- 08.00 A.M. Breakfast (ABF) which is cooked by guide.
- 09.00 A.M. Starting to walk down to the village about 2 hours.
- 11.00 A.M. Experience with ***elephant trekking*** down the hill and cross the stream and followed by ***bamboo rafting*** along the stream amidst beautiful scenery back to the village.
- 12.30 P.M. Lunch with the ***BBQ*** chicken and sweet ***sticky rice*** in the bamboo box.
- 04.00 P.M. Board the ***train*** along the wooden viaduct follow the historical route known as ***Death Railway.*** About 30 minutes on the train.
- 05.30 P.M. Return to your accommodation.
