The Beginnings

Titans Netball Club was formed originally by Lorraine Beel & Claire Turner in the Summer of 2002.

Claire & Lorraine had been friends for many years, but playing for separate teams in Division One of the North Devon Netball League, so they decided they wanted to form a new team together.

Training began on a Wednesday evening at Park School in Barnstaple, and a Titans senior team entered the North Devon Winter League in September 2002.

At the end of their first season, Titans finished fourth in Division One.

Two years later and with the help of Karen Jones (Devon Active Sports) a six week junior netball course was held at South Molton Community College. The course was well attended and with the help of an extremely dedicated bunch of girls with a lot of coaching and umpiring experience, a Junior Titans Section was set up.

In May 2005 Titans Netball Club were only the third club in East Devon County to be awarded their England Netball CAPS Accreditation at Silver Award Level & their Sport England Club Mark Accreditation. **Titans now have progressed to being at the highest level, having been awarded 'GOLD' status from 2014.**

And signifies our commitment to being a safe, effective child friendly sports club.

Going in 2022, Titans have 11 senior teams playing in the North Devon Senior League, as well as four x U11, one x U12, and four x U14 teams playing in the North Devon Junior League. Training numbers for our Juniors for 2021 are at U11's = 45; U12's = 10; U14's = 48; and U16's = 20, and 120 seniors. Titans currently have one senior team playing in the South West Regional Division 2, and also an U16 and U14 team in the South West Regional Division 2. We also have a branch at Tiverton

About Us!

Titans Netball Club was first formed with the aim of bringing people together and also to provide a social and fitness activity to committed players looking to improve their netballing abilities.

The Club is also committed to making netball more accessible to women and girls in this rural central Devon area and it is also keen to foster and promote the game so that people of all ages and abilities enjoy the game at all levels.

Through membership of Titans Netball Club, players are able to receive regular coaching by England Netball Level 1/Level 2/ Level 3 coaches as well as tutelage in Netball Umpiring by a fully qualified England Netball Umpiring Tutor/Mentor.

Titans Netball Club is also keen to see the progression of junior players through the ranks to senior level, giving them the opportunity of playing all standards, from local North Devon League fixtures, Performance/County Academy, Team Bath Futures, to South West Senior Regional standard.

All our junior coaching staff have had the usual Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks and attend appropriate courses, such as Safeguarding, First Aid & Time To Listen, on a regular basis as part of Continuing Professional Development (CPD).

The Club also welcomes senior members.

We currently have a membership of 240, with the youngest being 5 years old and the oldest member being of 73 years old.

We also have set up a new Tiverton branch, with 100 members.

Not only do we welcome playing members, we also welcome non playing members who may wish to have an involvement in the club through coaching and umpiring, table officiating at local or national events, or just lend their support.

The Teams & Training

Juniors (5 to 14)

Titans Netball Club runs a Junior Netball Club for five to fourteen year olds. (Year 1 to 6)

Boys are welcome up to Year 6.

We train our U14's/U12's & U11's every week on a Wednesday evening at Park School, Barnstaple from 5.30pm to 6.45pm/7pm on the outside courts.

During the months of September to April, the Junior League commences with League games taking place once/twice a month on Sunday mornings 9.45am to 1pm (midday for U11's).

There are separate ages groups: U11's, Under 12's & U14's.

Juniors (14 to 18) (Year 10 and above)

We train every Wednesday evening at Park School, Barnstaple from 7 to 9pm on the outside courts with the Senior members of Titans NC.

Year 10 and above are able to participate in the North Devon Senior League on a Monday night at Park School.

Titans Netball Club Senior training sessions take place every Wednesday evening at Park School, Barnstaple from 7 to 9pm on the outside courts. If wet conditions, we have access to the Sports Hall.

Senior League matches are played on Monday evenings at Park School.

Senior SW Regional Squad training takes place on the 1st & 3rd Thursday of the month at Chulmleigh Community College/Park School from 7 to 9pm, between the months of September to April.

We currently have one senior team competing in the South West Regional League on Saturdays.

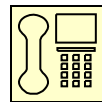
Team Lightning (Div 2) all across the South West Region.

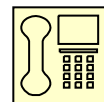

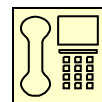

Code of Conduct For Players

Titans Netball Club is committed to everyone having the right to enjoy Netball in an atmosphere free from threat and intimidation, harassment and abuse. To that end the club expects all members to adhere to the codes of conduct stipulated below.

All club members must conduct themselves in a way that respects other members

- All club members must consider their own and the safety and well being of others at all times
- The club members will display a consistently respectful standard of behaviour and should not act in a way (either verbally or physically) that could bring the club's name into disrepute.
- All club members will follow the rules as laid down by the organisations to which the club is affiliated.
- No club member must condone any rule violations (including the use of prohibited substances)
- All members will encourage and value the performance of other members regardless of age, ability, gender, race, ethnicity, religious beliefs, sexuality or social/economic status.
- Where there are all alleged breaches in this code of conduct all club members have a personal responsibility to positively challenge the breach and ensure that the chairperson or other available club official is aware of what has taken place. It is then the responsibility of the chairperson to ensure that relevant investigation and action is taken in relation to the alleged breach.

Discipline

The Executive Committee can suspend the membership of any individual whose actions are alleged to have broken the club rules or to have brought the club into disrepute. The Executive Committee will then hold a special meeting (separate to other core business) to decide the validity of the allegations. The club member and an advocate may attend that meeting but will not be involved in the decision making. It is at the discretion of the Executive Committee what action will be taken (where necessary in consultation with AENA) and ultimately it has the right to exclude people from the club.

In the event of an appeal against the decision, the Chair of the club will request the assistance from the North Devon Netball League Committee in formulating a small review group. This group should normally meet within 14 days of the appeal being received and advise the player of its decision within 28 days of the appeal being received.

Code Of Conduct for Coaches, Officials & Volunteers

As a coach, official or volunteer of Titans Netball Club I will try to work within the following guidelines:

- Always ensure that I am never left alone with one child. Avoid situations where an individual child (that is not my own) and myself are completely unobserved.
- If any form of physical support is required, it will be provided openly and according to guidelines provide by the England Netball.
- Where possible, parents/guardians will take on the responsibility for their young people in the changing rooms. If young people have to be supervised in the changing rooms, the club will try to ensure that coaches/volunteers work in pairs.
- Encourage an open environment (i.e. no secrets, always explain why you are doing something in that way, encourage a diplomatic approach to the club's activities with young people being able to put their views forward).
- When working with the teams, the club will agree with parents/guardians when it is appropriate to enter the changing area.
- Include young people in committee decisions to ensure their voice is heard.

As a coach, official or volunteer of Titans Netball Club I will avoid:

- Spending excessive amounts of time alone with young people away from others.
- Taking young people (apart from my own relations) alone on car journeys, however short.
- Taking young people (apart from my own relations) to my home where they will be alone with me.

As a coach, official or volunteer of Titans Netball Club I will never:

- Engage in rough, physical or sexually provocative games, including horseplay.
- Share a room with a young person (apart from my own relations).
- Allow of engage in any form of inappropriate touching.
- Allow young people to use inappropriate language unchallenged.
- Make sexually suggestive comments to a young person, even in fun.
- Do things of a personal nature for young people that they can do for themselves.
- Invite or allow young people (apart from my own relations) to stay with me at my home unsupervised.
- Allow allegations to be made by a child to go unchallenged, unrecorded or not acted upon.

Code of Conduct for Parents, Carers & Supporters

As a parent, carer and supporter of **Titans Netball Club**, try to work within the following guidelines:

Do not force an unwilling child to participate in netball.

Remember children are involved in netball for their enjoyment not yours.

Encourage your children to play to the rules and not to argue with umpires or other officials.

Teach your child that honest effort is more important than victory so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.

Turn losing into winning by helping your child work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship.

Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.

Remember that children learn best by example. Applaud good play by your team and by members of the opposition.

Do not question the umpire's decisions or honesty. Remember he/she is only human with the same feelings as you, and like you, can sometimes make an honest error.

Recognise the importance and value of coaches who are all volunteers. They give children their time and resources to provide netball for your child.

Read the rules of netball to understand better what you are watching and commenting on.

Promote this code of conduct to other parents, carers and supporters.

Child Protection Policy Statement

Titans Netball Club has adopted the following Child Protection Policy Statement as recognised by
The All England Netball Association Ltd:

“Organisation have a duty of care for young people and a responsibility to protect them from harm”

A child is defined as being under 18 years of age (The Children Act, 1989)

The All England Netball Association Limited (AENA) recognises its responsibilities under the terms of the Race Relations Act 1976, Sex Discrimination Act 1975, the Children Act 1989, the Protection of Children Act, 1999, the Disability Discrimination Act 1996 and the Human Rights Act, 1998. Every child who participates in Netball should be able to do so in a fun, safe environment and be protected from harm. The AENA places the highest priority on their safety and enjoyment and recognises that they have a duty towards children within the sport and any member providing Netball opportunities must do so with the highest possible standard of care. The AENA has based its Duty of Care guidelines on the following core values and principles:

Core Values

- All young people’s netball experiences must be guided by what is best for that young person
- Adults interacting with young people in netball should do so with integrity and respect for the child
 - All young people’s netball should be conducted in an atmosphere of fair play
 - Young people’s netball should be conducted in a safe, positive and encouraging atmosphere
 - Adults who take responsibility for young people in netball have a duty to ensure that they are competent to provide safe and rewarding experiences for those in their care, through appropriate training and education.

Principles

- The welfare of young people is paramount
- All people, but especially young people, whatever their culture, disability, gender, language, racial origin, religious belief or sexual identity, have a right to protection from abuse
- All incidents or poor practice, suspicions and allegations should be taken seriously and responded to swiftly and appropriately
- It is the responsibility of child protection experts to determine whether or not abuse has taken place, but it is everyone’s responsibility to report any concerns.
- Confidentiality should be upheld in line with the Data Protection Act 1998 and the Human Rights Act 1998.

Young people have a lot to gain from netball. Their natural sense of fun and spontaneity can blossom in positive sporting environments which promote progress in a child-centred way. Netball provides an excellent medium in which young people can learn new skills, become more confident and maximise their own unique potential.

Club Constitution

1 Name

The Club shall be called Titans Netball Club (hereinafter called the Club).

2 Affiliation

The Club shall be affiliated to the East Devon County of the All England Netball Association.

3 Aims and Objectives

3.1 The aims and objectives of the club will be:

- to offer coaching, umpiring, training and competitive opportunities in netball.
- to promote the club within the local community and netball.
- to ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club.
- to provide all its services in a way that is fair to everyone.
- to ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment.

3.2 The aim and objectives of the Club should be consistent with the furthering of equal opportunities for all groups in netball.

4 Equity Policy

4.1 The Club is committed to ensuring that equity is incorporated across all aspects of its development. In doing so it acknowledges and adopts the following Sport England and definition of sports equity:

Sport equity is about fairness in sport, equality of access, recognising inequalities and taking steps to address them, It is about changing the culture and structure of sport to ensure it becomes equally accessible to everyone in society.

4.2 The Club respects the rights, dignity and worth of every person and will treat everyone equally within the context of their sport, regardless of age, ability, gender, race, ethnicity, religious belief, sexuality or social/economic status.

4.3 The Club is committed to everyone having a right to enjoy their sport in an environment free from threat of intimidation, harassment and abuse.

4.4 All Club members have a responsibility to oppose discriminatory behaviour and promote equality of opportunity.

4.5 The Club will deal with any incidence of discriminatory behaviour seriously, according to Club disciplinary procedures.

5 Membership

5.1 Membership should consist of officers and members of the club.

5.2 All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the club deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the club has adopted.

5.3 Members will be enrolled in one of the following categories:

Senior Member; Student Member (in full time education); Junior Member (under 18);

Casual Member (+ pay as you play)

- 5.4 Junior members shall be given the same playing and voting rights within the Club as held by other members.
- 5.5 All members may resign from membership at any time by giving notice to the Membership Secretary.

6 Membership Fees

- 6.1 Membership fees will be set annually and agreed by the Executive Committee or determined at the Annual General Meeting.
- 6.2 There will be different set charges for Senior & Juniors.
- 6.3 There will be different set options for members re payment – IE League/Training price and just League Fee price.
- 6.4 The Executive Committee may decide upon other charges or subscriptions at its discretion.

7.2 Officers will be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting.

7.3 All officers will retire each year but will be eligible for re-appointment.

8 Executive Committee

8.1 The Club will be managed through the Executive Committee consisting of:

8.2 Only these posts will have the right to vote at meetings of the Executive Committee.

8.3 The Executive Committee will be convened by the General Secretary of the Club and held no less than 2 meetings per year.

8.4 The quorum required for business to be agreed at Executive Committee meetings will be 4.

8.5 The Executive Committee will be responsible for adopting new policy, codes of conduct and rules that affect the organisation of the club.

8.6 The Executive Committee will have powers to appoint sub-committees as necessary and appoint advisers to the Executive Committee as necessary to fulfil its business.

- 8.7 The Executive Committee will be responsible for disciplinary hearings of members who infringe the club rules/regulations/constitution. The Executive Committee will be responsible for taking any action of suspension or discipline following such hearings.
- 8.8 Every decision at a meeting of the Executive Committee shall be determined by a majority vote of the members present and every voting member having one vote. In the event of an equality of the votes, the Chairperson of the meeting shall have a casting vote.
- 8.9 The interpretation of the Club constitution shall be vested in the Executive Committee, who shall decide all questions relating to the Club, save those specified in or involving an amendment to the constitution.
- 8.10 The Executive Committee shall be responsible for considering any application for membership and shall decide if this application should be accepted. The decision shall be in accordance with the equity policy specified in section 4.

9 Finance

- 9.1 All club monies will be banked in an account held in the name of the Club.
- 9.2 The Club Treasurer will be responsible for the finances of the Club.
- 9.3 All monies raised by or on behalf of the Club shall be applied to further the aims and objectives of the Club and for no other purpose.
- 9.4 The financial year of the Club will end on 31st December.
- 9.5 An audited statement of annual accounts will be independently reviewed & presented by the Treasurer at the Annual General Meeting.
- 9.6 Any cheque drawn against the Club funds should hold the signatures of the Treasurer plus one other officer.

10 Annual General Meetings

- 10.1 The Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Club shall be held every year during the month of May when the annual report of the Executive Committee and the Audited statement of accounts up to the end of the financial year shall be presented.
- 10.2 Notice of the Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be given by the Club General Secretary. Not less than 21 clear days' notice to be given to all members.
- 10.3 Nominations for officers of the Executive Committee will be sent to the General Secretary prior to the AGM.
- 10.4 Elections of officers are to take place at the AGM.
- 10.5 All members have the right to vote at the AGM.
- 10.6 Every decision at an AGM shall be determined by a majority vote of the members present and every voting member having one vote. In the event of an equality of the votes, the Chairperson of the meeting shall have the casting vote.
- 10.7 The quorum for AGMs will be a representative from each Senior Team in the NDNL.
- 10.8 The Executive Committee has the right to call Extraordinary General Meetings (EGMs) outside the AGM. Procedures for EGMs will be the same as for the AGM.

11 Discipline and Appeals

- 11.1 All complaints regarding the behaviour of members should be submitted in writing to the General Secretary.
- 11.2 The Executive Committee will meet to hear complaints within 28 days of a complaint being lodged. The committee has the power to take appropriate disciplinary action including the termination of membership.
- 11.3 The outcome of a disciplinary hearing should be notified in writing to the person who lodged the complaint and the member against whom the complaint was made within 14 days of the hearing.
- 11.4 There will be the right of appeal to the Executive Committee following disciplinary action being announced. The committee should consider the appeal within 28 days of the General Secretary receiving the appeal.

12 Trophies & Property

- 12.1 Any person who receives a trophy or property, including kit and equipment belonging to the Club, is responsible for its safekeeping and ensuring it is returned in good condition. Failure to do so may result in that person paying for a replacement.

13 Dissolution

- 13.1 A resolution to dissolve the Club can only be passed at an AGM or EGM through a majority vote of the membership.
- 13.2 In the event of dissolution, any assets of the Club that remain will become the property of the North Devon Netball League.

14 Amendments to the Constitution

The constitution shall only be changed through agreement by majority vote at an AGM or EGM.

15 Declaration

Titans Netball Club hereby adopts and accepts this constitution as a current operating guide regulating the actions of members.

Equity Policy Statement

Titans Netball Club is committed to ensuring that equity is incorporated across all aspects of its development. In doing so it acknowledges and adopts the following Sport England definition of sports equity:
