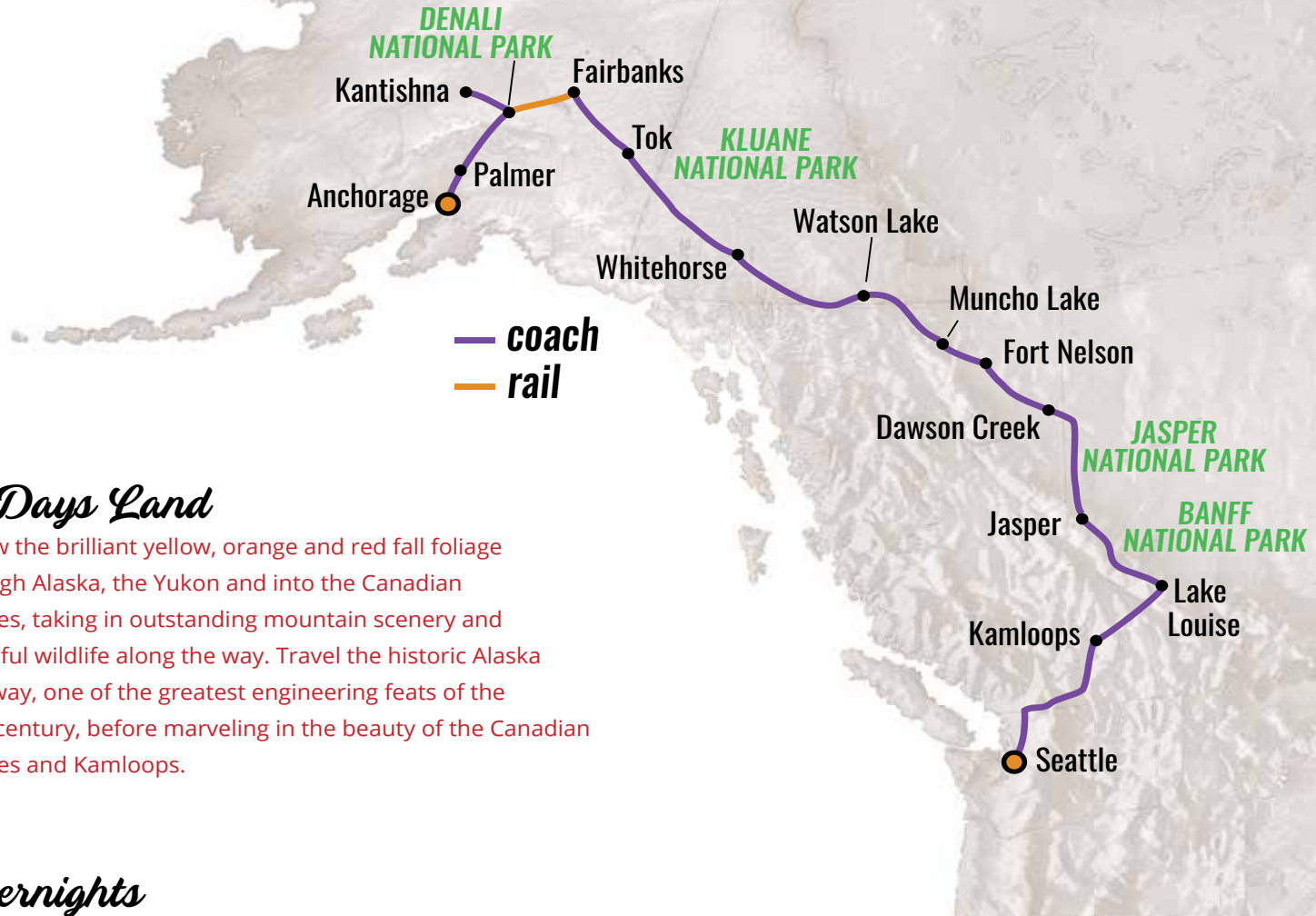

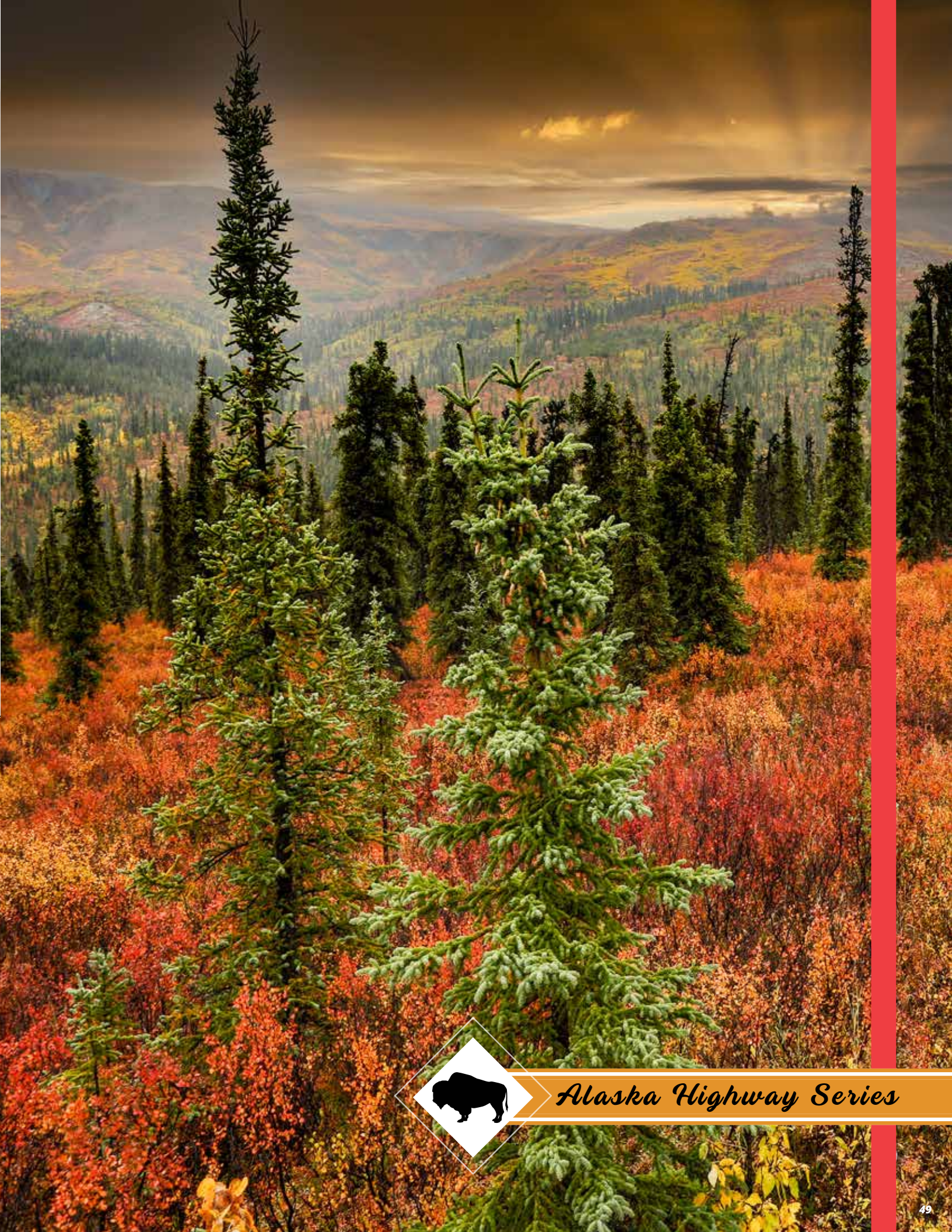

Arranging Flights

This tour begins in Anchorage, Alaska and ends in Seattle, Washington. You may arrive at any time of day on day 1 and depart at any time of day on day 18.

1 Anchorage

Arrive in Anchorage, be greeted by our staff and transferred to the Hotel Captain Cook, your home for the evening. *Dinner*

2 Anchorage & Palmer

After breakfast, enjoy a city tour of Anchorage with time at the wonderful Anchorage Museum, showcasing Alaska's rich cultural heritage. Journey north to Palmer this afternoon. Your afternoon is free for relaxation or exploration at the Knik River Lodge. *All Meals*

3 Knik River Lodge

Enjoy a relaxed morning before your journey north to Denali National Park where you will have lunch and time at the Denali Visitor's Center before arriving at your Denali accommodations. Take in sweeping views of Denali from the back porch of your room. *All Meals*

4 Denali National Park & Kantishna

After breakfast, join a private sightseeing bus for a 95-mile wildlife tour. Keep your eyes open for moose, caribou, Dall sheep, wolves and brown bears. Spend a few hours in Kantishna enjoying lunch and some gold panning. Return to the gates of the park this afternoon. *All Meals*

5 Denali Adventure Day & Fairbanks

Begin your day with your choice of included activity, furthering your exploration of Denali National Park. Choose to join an ATV trek, go ziplining through the forest, or join a white water river rafting adventure. Helicopter tours of Denali are available for an additional cost. After lunch, board the first-class cars of the Alaska Railroad for a 4-hour journey to Fairbanks where you will spend two nights. *All Meals*

6 Fairbanks

Begin your day with a 3-hour journey aboard the Riverboat Discovery. Next, learn about the sport of dog mushing during an exclusive luncheon at Trail Breaker Kennels, where Dave Monson and family will take you out to interact with the dogs. Dine at the Alaska Salmon Bake this afternoon followed by a rowdy show at the Palace Theatre, documenting the settling of Fairbanks. *All Meals*

7 Fairbanks & Tok

First we will visit the Fountainhead Auto Museum's collection of vintage cars and costumes. Following that is a stop at the North Pole and Santa's House to mail those Christmas wish lists. Your journey on the Alaska Highway begins this afternoon! Keep your camera ready as the scenery will be grand! Arrive in Tok this afternoon. *All Meals*

8 Kluane National Park & Whitehorse

Visit stunning Kluane National Park and tour the Da Ku Cultural Center. Your day will be filled with mountains, lakes and plentiful wildlife along the way! Arrive in Whitehorse, the capital of the Yukon. *All Meals*

9 Watson Lake

Leaving Whitehorse, witness Teslin Lake before arriving at the famed Signpost Forest. Bring along a sign from your home town to add to the several thousand already at home here. *All Meals*

10 Muncho Lake

Spend your morning enjoying the dramatic views of the river and cliffs that surround you. Arrive at scenic Muncho Lake, one of North America's most prolific wildlife viewing areas. Relax on the banks of Muncho Lake, with the late afternoon free for exploring this beautiful area. *All Meals*

11 Fort Nelson

Pass through amazing Stone Mountain Provincial Park, home of the beautiful Stone Sheep. With any luck we will witness these impressive animals licking salt along the highway and up on roadside cliffs. Visit the Fort Nelson Heritage Museum's memorable displays before arriving at your hotel. *All Meals*

12 Dawson Creek

Before entering Alberta, make a stop in Dawson Creek, home to "Mile Post 0" and the completion of your journey on the Alaska Highway. *All Meals*

13 Jasper National Park & Jasper

Make your way to the Canadian Rockies and through Jasper National Park this morning. Look for mountain sheep and elk along the way! Spend your afternoon in this wonderful mountain village. *All Meals*

14 Icefields Parkway & Athabasca Glacier

Witness roaring Athabasca Falls before lunch overlooking Athabasca Glacier. Join an Ice Explorer coach ride on Athabasca Glacier and hike around on the glacier. Overnight in the middle of the Columbia Icefields at The Crossing Resort. *All Meals*

15 Banff & Banff National Park

Visit Peyto Lake, Lake Louise & Moraine Lake before arriving in Banff. Take a breathtakingly beautiful gondola ride up Sulphur Mountain. Once at the top, have lunch, explore the short hiking trails, and visit the interpretive center. After a free afternoon in Banff, return to The Crossing Resort for dinner. *All Meals*

16 Kamloops

Step back in time at the heritage ghost town of Three Valley Gap with a guided tour of the historic buildings before entering the Cascade Mountains. The scenery in Kamloops is stunning. Your hotel allows you multiple places to relax and enjoy the view! *All Meals*

17 Seattle

See beautiful Puget Sound before arriving in the bustling city of Seattle, Washington. Enjoy the afternoon free in Seattle before dinner at your hotel. *All Meals*

18 Fly Home

After breakfast, transfer to the Seattle airport to board your flight bound for home. *Breakfast*
