

Lodi Agricultural Fair's Kiddie Kar Derby Saturday, July 13th, 2019

Information and Rules:

6:30 pm Registration (Paperwork must be signed by parent or guardian prior to participation)

6:45 pm Start

Participants MUST provide own VEHICLE and HELMET

Ribbons and food tokens will be awarded.

Depending on Entries: There may be 2 separate groups Stock Power Wheels ~ parts replaced OK Extreme Modified Power Wheels ~ extreme bumpers, bigger motors, and rebuilds Officials will decide the day of the event

- 1. No ATV/Motorcycle Power Wheels Allowed.
- 2. No open leg/foot area

3. Child MUST be a minimum of 4 years old. Child MUST fit within the driver's compartment. No knees or legs extending outside of the vehicle

5. Helmets are REQUIRED and MUST be strapped on at ALL times! Acceptable Options: bike, motor cross, snowmobile or motorcycle helmets.

6. Batteries MUST be secured and covered at all times

- a. 12- volt batteries ARE allowed ~ lawn mower battery
- b. NO large truck or implement batteries
- 7. Power wheels can be decorated in good taste and with a car number
- 8. ONE adult will be allowed on the track to help/watch over their child
- 9. Participation waivers MUST be signed by legal parent or guardian

Grandstand Pit/Track Regulations:

Children are not allowed in the pit/track area until event is announced by Derby Officials.

Children and parent/guardian will receive a colored wrist band to designate them as participants. Children and ONE adult will be allowed to enter pit/track area through the security gate located on the North end of grandstand by eatery/beer gardens. All parents/guardians and participants will be asked to leave pit/track area once the child has completed their derby run.

NO entry fee for derby - Participants receive a free entry to the entire derby with a paid parent/guardian grandstand ticket ~ \$7 Pit passes are not required UNLESS staying in pit area for entire event; these passes are available at the pit gate for \$20; children under the age of 16 may not stay in pit area.

Parents/guardians are asked to pre-register children and bring in power wheel vehicle prior to event. Label power wheel with parent/guardian name. Pit entrance opens at 1pm; we encourage parking in the North parking lot after power wheel is registered~ entrance is located on county road 2.
