JUNIOR CLASSES - DANISH JUDGING

All exhibitors in the Junior Fair division shall be a member of an organized youth organization under adult supervision.

- 1. **JR EXHIBIT HALL CHECK-IN:** Wednesday from 4pm to 8pm and Thursday from Noon to 6pm.
- 2. Judging starts Friday morning at 9am.
- 3. Exhibits may not be removed from the fairgrounds before 4pm on Sunday. Violators will forfeit premiums.
- 4. All exhibits must be removed from the fairgrounds between 4pm and 6pm Sunday of the fair unless other arrangements are made with the superintendent prior to the show.
- 5. Exhibitors must be between the ages of 8-20 years old as of January 1st of current fair year. Exception in department 17J Exploring & Cloverbuds and 26J Clothing | Class K Clothing Revue only.
- 6. All ages determined as of January 1st of current fair year.
- 7. Judging questions and concerns will be addressed by judges on Friday from 9am to 2pm. Livestock show questions will be addressed during the show. Judges decisions are final.

DEPARTMENT 26J CLOTHING REVUE

NOTE: This is a PRE-FAIR event. Judging starts promptly at 6:00pm on Tuesday July 10 in the Jr Exhibit Hall.

- I. Entries will be judged on
 - a. Suitability of garment for individual as to color and design.
 - b. General appearance, neatness, posture, and fit.
 - c. Construction to the extent that it affects general appearance. (Judges have the choice of inspecting garment construction techniques).
- II. Clothing Revue garments may be entered in the clothing exhibit classes under Department 26J (classes A & B)
- III. Clothing members are encouraged to bring their patterns and guide sheets with them.
- IV. Each garment must have a description card filled out for the revue. Card may be obtained from department superintendent or at the fair office on entry day. They must be returned prior to the revue.
- V. All Clothing Revue garments must be on display during the fair. Bring on entry day. Please include your Clothing Revue entry on your Fair Entry Form.
