

THE REQUIREMENT

Photographic Record of the Built Heritage of Chipping Campden

Our aim is to achieve a definitive record at the beginning of this century of the fronts of all the buildings in the extended High Street together with good streetscape coverage of spurs off it and Westington.

Film (black and white and/or colour to be decided) and digital photography should be taken together.

Frontage of buildings in the extended High Street

The sides of the street to be covered are shown in green on the map. We favour frontal, somewhat panoramic still photography in overlapping frames to give comprehensive coverage. Each photo should have its place in the scheme and the series should be capable of display as an extended panorama.

It also seems to us that the photos would be more complete from footings to roof level if they could be taken at first floor from across the street. We think that cooperation to realise this is achievable. Ideally, of course, cars should be moved from the street in front of the buildings being photographed. This would involve much public inconvenience and a great deal of organisation. However, it might be possible to achieve it in front of buildings of particular historic or architectural interest by coning off in advance and removing at the last moment.

Other Streetscape Coverage

The spurs and other streets to be recorded, shaded blue on the map, are:

- Cidermill Lane, Church Street and Calf Lane
- West End Terrace, part of Hoo Lane and Back Ends
- Sheep Street, Westington, Blind Lane back into Park Road

On these streets the need is for progressive streetscape coverage – in the direction shown on the map – of both sides together or left and right. The interval of shots to achieve the detail required needs to be agreed.

Note. The above coverage should capture a record of at least the fronts of some 220 listed buildings. Some record of other important listed buildings, by agreement with their owners, will be required to complete the record. These include St James' Church, Old Campden House, The Old Silk Mill, Westington Haydon's and Berrington Mills, Westington Manor with Dovecote, Conduit House and Campden House. *These are not in this requirement.*
