



#### **HIKURANGI HISTORICAL MUSEUM**



Recently the museum was gifted some items from the former Hikurangi Lodge No. 140 by one of its members. The Hikurangi Lodge was founded 19th of May, 1905. In 2005 the Lodge had its centenary, but a few years ago it was disestablished.

We were gifted a fine portrait photograph of the first Master the Lodge, Alexander Mearns Rust, who was in charge of the Hikurangi Lodge for one year. He was also Headmaster at the Hikurangi School and the grandfather of

the well known potter and artist Yvonne Rust. Many other Masters followed him in the years after. On the 26 July 1918 new Lodge Rooms were opened in Alfred Street. The building of the Masonic Lodge is still there, but it is privately owned now. A book with the history of the Hikurangi Lodge was published to celebrate the centenary. You can look at it at the museum if you want to find out more about the Masonic Lodge. In the future we hope to profile the Lodge as one of the many community groups and churches doing important mahi in Hikurangi, so please contact us if you have information to share with us about any of these.

Our next exhibition however will be Decorative Arts & Decorative Arts amp; Crafts of the Hikurangi Area. We hope to have this new exhibition set up by Waitangi day. Thanks to WDC Creative Communities funding we are pleased to be able to offer a series of 5 different introductory arts and crafts workshops for the community, held at the Hikurangi Museum towards the end of January.

Workshops will be on Cyanotypes & Dilhouettes; Printmaking; Needle Felting; Embroidery & De Creative Stitching; and Raranga. Each workshop will be 2 hours in length. Spaces per workshop will be limited to 12 participants. Just \$5 a session to help cover material costs. We would love to see grandparents and grandchildren being creative together! Some of the workshops may have a minimum age limit to ensure safe handling of tools and materials.

Please email us at the museum with enquiries and expressions of interest if you wish to attend. More I nformation will be posted on the Hikurangi Museum Facebook page (so follow us!), and physically on the noticeboard outside Friendship House.

#### Recipe For Valentine's Day

**Ingredients:** ½ a packet of Kingston biscuits 30g melted butter cup thickened cream 5g block white chocolate melted and cooled 125g fresh raspberries & icing sugar for dusting

Method:

- Place biscuits in a food processor, process until finely chopped. Add butter, then process until just combined.
- 2) Divide mixture evenly between 2 x 2cm deep 10cm based heart shaped tins. Using the back of a metal press mixture over base & side of tins. Refigerate for 30 minutes
- 3) Whisk cream until soft peaks form. Add chocolate. Using a big metal spoon gently fold until well mixed. Carefully remove biscuit cases from tins. Divide cream mixture between cases. Then top with raspberries on top of each case and serve.
- 4) You can use any fruit that is available, also any shape you wish to use.
