

HIKURANGI HISTORICAL MUSEUM



Over the years, community fundraising has enabled much of Hikurangi's progress. A couple of examples we have written about previously include the opening of the waterworks scheme, and to help the Fire Brigade purchase equipment in the early 20^{th} C.

Today, the Hikurangi Museum is asking for your help - to raise funds to purchase conservation materials. These funds will help us store historic photographs of our community safely in the museum archive. Thanks to the generosity of local businesses and individuals who have contributed prizes, we have a raffle for two fabulous prize bundles. The raffle will be drawn next month (Spring) and it is just \$5 a ticket. Two winners will be drawn - the first gets to choose which prize option they prefer. 

HIKURANGI POLICE

Policeman Rado (Greg) Here-turi-kōkā/August

Tēnā koutou katoa and Hari huri tau/Happy birthday for everyone who's birthday it is this month.

Another month or two have rolled by since my last Bulletin piece. We are now on the last month of Hōtoke/Winter which for one I am very pleased about. Looking forward to Raumati/Summer this year! Still a few months away though! For me and Josh we have been busy, and as I'm writing this, someone on a black road bike thinks Valley Road is a quarter mile strip! Which brings me into speed restrictions out and around our town, 50km/h in the Hikurangi area until you go out onto SH1 and Marua Rd.

Certain times of the day for school, normally mornings and afternoons, have zoned areas that are speed restricted. 40km/h during these times are the maximum speed any vehicleshould be going in these zoned areas!

This leads me into RIDS. Generally what Pirihimana focus on. RIDS:

- -Restraints seatbelts.
- -Impairment alcohol and drugs.
- -Distractions cell phone use.
- -Speed I shouldn't have to say much Slow down drive to the conditions and posted speed limit for the area.

You may have noticed the extra Police vehicles in and around the Hikurangi area. Majority of these Policing units are Traffic units who have a zero tolerance for RIDS abusers.

A heads up for all who are reading this, we will again be doing random check points focusing on RIDS so don't be surprised when you come across us on one of the streets.

On a helping note, from Josh and I, if anyone is struggling to obtain a driver's licence, being a learner's class car licence or struggling to graduate from a learner to a restricted or full driver's licence, come into the station and see us, we can assist by submitting a referral to a partner agency that Police work alongside who will help out. All they require is a contact phone number so they can make contact and start the ball rolling!

There have been a few reported burglaries in our area, recently whanau who have moved into our community to have a Toanga/Treasure taken off their deck. We managed to return it home, but in saying what is not yours, keep your hands off.

Please be vigilant, keep an eye on your neighbours and secure your property. Any suspicious behaviour even if you're not sure, report it. Again, registrations for suspicious vehicles, and if able to, description of suspicious persons. And like always call 111 if it's happening now/emergency or 105 if it has happened already/non-emergency.

Respectively if you have access to internet and can't get through to 105 via phone, go online to 105.police.govt.nz and make a report.

That's me for this month, stay safe dry and warm out there and we'll see you out and about.
