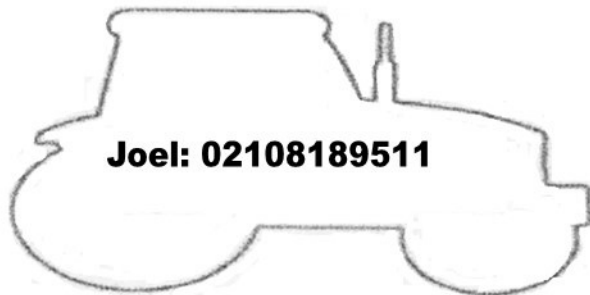

Hikurangi Community Library July / August in the garden.

It has been a wet muddy season so far. I know we have all had enough, and not a great time for growing vegetables. We must forge ahead though, with the cost of living rising and no relief in sight, now is the time to get your vege gardens in order. It is a great time for pulling weeds as the ground is soft and they seem to be the most prolific thing growing in my garden right now! Get your beds prepared for spring planting. Keep the beds mulched even if you have nothing planted in there. The is still time to plant some winter vegetables. Broccoli, cabbage, beetroot, lettuce, beans, peas, leafy greens, and it is still not too late for garlic.

Start sprouting potatoes and get those beds ready too. Start your spring seeds off indoors for early spring planting.

We have not done a spring seeds order for the seed swap in the library but will do that in the next few weeks. There is still lots in the seed swap to get you going. How this works is you become a library member and you can come in and swap seeds for seeds or pay 50 cents a pack. Each pack contains enough for 1 or 2 seed trays.

See you at the Hikurangi Library soon for seeds and remember we always have new books coming in.

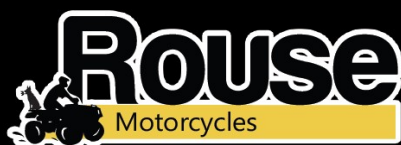

Another busy month for us in Hikurangi, the cold weather has really hit and with that the cold and flu. Keep warm team and if anyone is struggling with warmth, we could put our feelers out and try to get some help for you.

I sound like a broken record but still we are getting issues with speed around the community, daily I hear from business owners on King Street about vehicles speeding down the built-up area. If you witness this, please call 105 to report these issues, this will paint a picture of the issue in Hikurangi and we can follow up with the registered owners.

You may have seen a rise in Police vehicles in the community, some of these are road policing units and they have zero tolerance with alcohol/licences/warrants/regos and defects with vehicles. It has been noted the increase of driving issues we have been coming across and therefore more units are attending the area to help with the workload.

We are noticing a lot of dogs running around on the road and some being struck by vehicles, please ensure your animals are kept safe at home in an enclosed yard. Please be careful when driving out to the coast as the amount of cattle wondering on the road is concerning, some of these animals are wild and can be standing in the middle of the road. Drive safe and be aware of these issues.

HIKURANGI VOLUNTEER FIRE BRIGADE

Hi Hikurangi

In the coming weeks we will be doing a big training night, with crews from Kamo and Whangarei Operational Support joining us for the night with all sorts of training taking place, so if you see lots of fire trucks out here Hika don't panic.

With so much constantly changing weather lately remember to drive to the conditions, frosty mornings can potentially leave us with icy roads. Constant rainy days leave our roads slippery, care is required in all conditions on the road.

Make sure you have had your chimney swept, always use a fire guard with an open fire.

Put all ashes in a metal bucket and pour water over the bucket, ashes can remain hot for 5 days.

Have your electric blanket checked by a qualified electrician, make sure that it lays flat on the bed, that the cords and controls are not twisted.

Remember the heater metre rule, keep a clear metre around fireplaces and heaters, do not cover or store things on top of them.

Did you know that the history of our Tennis Club in Hikurangi goes back over 100 years? The Bowling Club first put down three grass courts in 1917 because several people had expressed their wish to play tennis. In the same year a Tennis Club was officially formed at a public meeting. Funds were raised and an arrangement was made with the Bowling Club to lease a piece of land sufficient for six courts. The Tennis Club started to prosper. In the 1920s four of the six courts were asphalted. During the Second World War the courts got into a bad state of disrepair. A meeting was held in November 1947 to revive the Hikurangi Tennis Club and the three courts owned by the club were relaid as a result. In 1952 the club became an Incorporated Society. It had A and B teams as well as a junior team and they used to play against other clubs in the area. Later on, the Hikurangi Tennis Club joined the Mid Northern Tennis Club Association based in Hukerenui. In 1987 the club had to close for three years because of the declining membership but re-started again in 1990. In 2017 a decision was made that the Hikurangi Tennis Club would give it's land to the Whangārei District Council to allow a major update into a multi-use sports facility for tennis, football, futsal, netball and hockey.
