Schedule A Dog prohibition areas

The following areas are designated as dog prohibited areas:

1. All Council Buildings including Forum North and all public libraries.
This includes the Hikurangi Hall but not the Hikurangi Library.
2. All marked sports fields.
This means dogs must be kept off the actual fields marked out for the game. Not around the edges.
3. All cemeteries (unless otherwise authorised by the Chief Executive Officer in writing) Central Business District as indicated in Appendix 1 (map A) attached hereto All wetlands including but not limited to:
4. Kioreroa Road wetlands situated on the western side of Kioreroa Road
5. Barge Park wetlands Matakoho/Limestone Island. All bush reserves including but not limited to:
6. Pukenui Forest including Western Hills
7. Mt. Aubrey, high track only
8. Parihaka reserve between the Hatea walkway and the Parihaka memorial,
9. AH Reed Park and excluding bush reserves identified in Schedule B Kensington Park Children's Play Areas

Kumara, Carrot & Feta Fritters; Preparation time 15 mins. Cook time 15 mins. Serves 4

Vegetarian

Ingredients: Large orange kūmara, grated, 1 Medium carrot grated, 1 Red onion grated, 1/2 Garlic grated, 2 clove, Chopped parsley 1/2 cup, Pinch of chilli flakes, Cumin 1/2 tsp,



2 Eggs, Self-raising flour 1/2 cup, Salt 1/2 tsp, Crumbled feta 100 gms & Oil to cook.

Pickled Red Onion: 1/2 Red onion, sliced thinly, Salt 1/4 tsp, White wine vinegar 1 Tbsp & Caster sugar 2 tsp.



Method

1. Firstly pickle the onions. Into a small bowl place the onion and salt, massaging together. Add the vinegar and sugar.
2. Leave to sit for 15 minutes while you make the fritters.
3. Into a large bowl mix together the kumara, carrot, onion, garlic, parsley, chilli flakes, cumin, eggs, flour, salt and feta.
4. Heat a little oil in a frying pan. Add a large tablespoon of mixture to the pan, cooking a few at a time for 3 or 4 minutes on each side. Remove and continue to cook the remainder. Serve warm with the pickled onions.

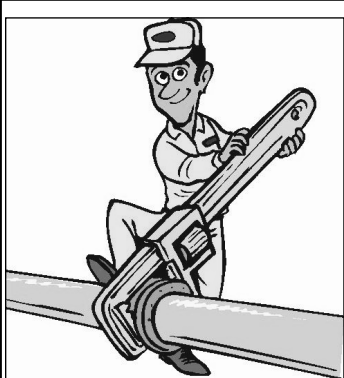

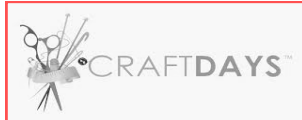
