A huge thank you to all that entered the competition, joined in the fun on the day, to our awesome stall holders and also to our fantastic sponsors who were so generous.


We are planning to hold this event again, so watch this space for when and come join us!!!

Our next step is to beautify the old Jail too. When Thomas Henry Beddek (the first constable to be stationed in our village) arrived in 1897, the jail was situated at the back of his house. Nowadays it houses

Our local Councillor Gavin Benney was previously a policeman in Hikurangi for 24 years. He has kindly offered his help with painting the museum and is booked in to talk to local school children who will be visiting the museum this week. Gavin wrote a book about his experiences, **Country Cop 24/7** - The life and times of a rural cop. We are looking forward to hearing about his interesting time as a police officer. He once held the informal title of "best clearance rate in the country".





Tēnā koutou katoa,

It's been a month or two since my last Bulletin piece. It is Monday 1st of May and I write this piece while in the office with the heat pump going.

Feeling the change of season is upon us. Like many I thought we got past the devastation of Cyclone Gabriel, only to be hit with another sub-tropical weather bomb over the weekend and the tail of it hanging around for the remainder of this week? I hope you're all managing alright and getting through without too much damage to your personal property/belongings

your personal property/belongings. With this, if there are any whanau struggling or not making ends meet, come into the station, have a korero with myself or Josh, we may be able to assist? We hold some food boxes at the station containing dry perishables so if there are whanau that are in need, by all means come see us.

We had a good turn out for the Anzac Service held here in Hikurangi, good march to the cenotaph, with a service and back to the bowling club for a few snacks and for some of the lucky ones, some beverages. Its good to see the young tamariki attending these services. ("At the going down of the sun and in the morning, we will Remember Them")

Officer Josh is settling in well and enjoying his start here. We have started doing random check points, restraints/seatbelts, driver's licenses, wofs and registrations along with alcohol are our focus. These check points will increase overtime and may include some late-night alcohol check points.

Our vehicles are now equipped with radars so please watch your speed, exceeding the limit will result in fines. If we flash you, turn our red and blue lights on, while driving, it's a warning, check your speed. A reminder to watch your speed around our Kura's/schools in the mornings and afternoons

mornings and afternoons.
Theft of cars and cars being dumped in our area has slowed down, probably due to one of our local boys being responsible for majority of these and now, he is having spent some time in the Ngawha Hotel. There have been a few reports of burglaries in and around our area with mainly battery-operated power tools and electronics being targeted.

The local 4 square was recently targeting and robbed, the offender was quickly nabbed in the Tikipunga area shortly afterwards. I'm not to sure what his thinking was behind his actions, lucky none of the staff involved were injured.

For everyone out there, if you see something suspicious, take some details of what you're seeing i.e., registration plates, description of person/s and give us a call so we can follow up. Please be vigilant, secure your property and keep a kanohi/eye out on your neighbour's property. Once again, the numbers for an emergency if it's happening now 111 and if its historical having already happened its 105 to take a report. The 105 reports, if in the Hikurangi area will eventually get assigned to me or Joshua. If it's a 111-call needing urgency it will get assigned to the nearest available unit.

Lastly I'd like to apologise for anyone who comes to the Hikurangi Station only to find it unmanned, sometimes it is a case of luck having a officer present when you arrive.

For now, stay safe out there, take care and look after each other.
