

# Our Wines

## **Clouds MCC 2019**

**350**

A hint of brioche, followed by bruised green apples on the nose. The palate is fresh and clean with lemon-like acidity. This wine is made from 100% Chardonnay grapes from our estate. It spent 12 months on the lees, adding to the finesse and a fine leesy texture from the bottle aging.

## **Clouds PINK Sauvignon Blanc 2020**

**295**

The Clouds “Pink” is our unique take on a rose style wine. Here we combine the freshness of sauvignon blanc with some of the lovely red and pink fruit notes found in syrah to ultimately create a wine perfect for summer. This vintage has lovely subtle floral notes on the nose while the palate is layered with citrus fruit and a persistent dry almost saline finish.

## **Clouds PINK Sauvignon Blanc 2021**

**295**

The 2021 vintage has unripe strawberry and subtle floral notes on the nose while the palate is layered with citrus and a persistent dry lingering finish.

## **Clouds Sauvignon Blanc 2019**

**295**

This 2019 vintage of Clouds sauvignon blanc is all about the freshness and delicate flavours that the variety is known for. On the nose there is an interesting play between green lime and passion fruit with a strong mineral core and hint of grapefruit following on the palate. The wine is held together beautifully by the higher than usual natural acidity of the 2019 vintage.

## **Clouds Sauvignon Blanc 2020**

**295**

Black current buds and limes make for an intriguing nose. The natural acidity of this Sauvignon blanc originates from the mountainous area of the Ceres Plateau where this wine is grown.

## **Clouds Sauvignon Blanc 2021**

**295**

On the nose you will notice freshly cut limes and tangerines. The palate is also citrus driven and bright with mouth-watering natural acidity from the 21 vintage to tie it all together.

## **Clouds Chenin Blanc 2020**

**350**

The fruit comes from old bush vines grown on decomposed granite soils in Wellington. The nose is very expressive with flavours of quince, citrus blossoms and some white pear. The palate is full but balanced by mineral notes typical of the granite soils its grown on and has a great natural acidity. The grapes are raised only in concrete and clay until bottling to preserve the delicate fruit.

## **Clouds Chenin Blanc 2021**

**350**

In this vintage the nose leads with passion fruit, citrus and a struck match mineral note typical of white wines fermented in concrete eggs. The palate is fresh but textured and balanced by some lovely mineral notes from the granite soils its grown on.

**Clouds Chardonnay 2018****395**

This wine has a wonderful entry that shows pear blossoms, lime and citrus undertones on the nose, which is also prominent on the palate. The wine is held together by a persistent line of acidity, adding to the freshness and longevity of the Chardonnay.

**Clouds Chardonnay 2019****395**

Freshly cut limes and citrus blossoms on the nose while the palate leads with stone fruit and a lovely leesy texture. The wine is held together by a persistent line of acidity, adding to the freshness and longevity allowing this wine to age and drink beautifully for years to come.

**Clouds Unwooded Chardonnay 2020****395**

The nose on this wine is very expressive and layered with fruit. Fresh cut limes, green apple and citrus blossoms aromas dominate this tank fermented wine. The palate is clean and precise with great balance between the fruit and natural acidity.

**Clouds RESERVE Chardonnay 2020****395**

The nose on this wine is delicate and layered with vibrant aromas of lime blossoms, white peach and citrus rind with some mineral and earthy tones in the background. The palate is led by stone fruit and minerality with chalk the first thing that comes to mind. This all tied together by fresh, precise acidity and a persistent leesy finish.

**Clouds RESERVE Chardonnay 2021****395**

The nose on this wine is delicate and layered with layers of green citrus and some flint dominating. The palate is energetic with precise acidity and a persistent steely finish.

**Clouds Pinot Noir 2019****395**

Dark and perfumed on the nose with purity and structure to match on the palate from the deep, rich clay it's grown on. A combination of juicy red and purple fruit now in its youth will develop into a typical pinot noir forest floor character over the next few years.

**Clouds Pinot Noir 2020****395**

This vintage of our Clouds estate grown Pinot Noir shows a lot of bright red fruit on the nose with light medium bodied structure to match on the palate. This expression of juicy red fruit in its youth will gain in complexity and develop typical earthy notes over the next few years.

**Clouds Pinot Noir 2021****395**

Our Clouds estate grown Pinot Noir shows a nose of wild strawberry, some savoury notes of cured meats and white pepper spice from the portion of the grapes where the ferment was done with whole bunches. The palate is fresh with crunchy tannins, juicy red fruit and a persistent finish.

**Clouds Shiraz 2019****395**

This shiraz made from grapes grown on the schist soils of the Swartland shows a medley of red and purple fruit and white pepper on the nose from the whole bunch fermentation. The palate is dense with well-integrated tannins and a long savoury finish.

**Clouds Shiraz 2020****395**

Dark and brooding with black olive and purple fruit on the nose. The palate has real weight and intensity. This wine will develop beautifully in the next 5 to 10 years. Semi-carbonic maceration adds to the spice profile of shiraz grown in the Swartland region.

**Clouds Shiraz 2021****395**

Grapes grown on the schist soils of the Swartland shows dark purple berry fruit and crushed black pepper on the nose from the whole bunch fermentation. The palate is fresh and fruit forward with well-integrated tannins and a long savoury finish.

**Clouds Bordeaux blend 2018****395**

Dark, almost inky in colour with violets and other purple fruit as well as a hint of tobacco dominating the nose. A most structured wine with firm, juicy tannins and a long persistent finish. An estate field blend of cabernet sauvignon, merlot and petit verdot grown on Clouds Estate and harvested, fermented and matured together as one wine. This wine spent 12 months on older French oak before it was bottled un-fined, with minimum filtration.

**Clouds Bordeaux blend 2019****395**

Deep, dark ruby red in colour with violets, cedar and red spices on the nose. Powerful and structured with firm tannins and intense dark fruits on the palate and a long, dry persistent finish. A field blend of Cabernet, Merlot and Petit Verdot grown on Clouds and uniquely harvested, fermented and matured together as one wine from the start. This wine spent 12 months in small French oak before it was bottled un-fined and with minimum filtration.

**Clouds Bordeaux Blend 2020****395**

Intensely perfumed with more black than red berries in this vintage. Violets, olive and earth also apparent on the nose while the palate is fresh but structured with firm tannins, intense dark fruits and a long dry persistent finish. An estate field blend as in previous years grown on Clouds and uniquely harvested, fermented and matured together as one wine once more. After 12 months in small French oak, it was bottled un-fined and with minimum filtration.

**MAGNUMS****Clouds Chardonnay 2017 MAGNUM****795**

A wine with a delicate, fresh entry and shows crushed seashells, citrus blossoms and freshly cut limes on the nose. The palate is tropical with a persistent mineral finish. Fermented and matured in a combination of concrete egg, amphora and small French oak barrels.

**Clouds Red Blend 2016 MAGNUM****795**

Dark and brooding, with black current and fynbos dominating the nose. The palate is rich & dense with ripe, round tannins and just enough acidity to balance the fruit. This is a blend of three varieties grown on Clouds and spent 20 months on oak.

**Clouds Pinot Noir 2017 MAGNUM****795**

This Pinot noir is fruit-forward and concentrated. The nose is deep and brooding and shows a medley of perfumed purple and black fruit with typical sour cherry, black current and also some earthy undertones. It's a complex wine with just the right balance of fruit, oak and acidity.

## WHITE WINES

### RIESLING

**Thelema Riesling 2016 – Stellenbosch 235**

Made in the German style, fragrant, spicy, slightly sweet with considerable complexity.

### CHENIN

**Kleine Zalze 'bush vine' Chenin Blanc 2019 – Stellenbosch 380**

Strong litchi, citrusy and guava aromas on the nose with ripe pineapple and peach flavours that follows through on the palate. This is a fresh and fruity style of Chenin Blanc.

**Luddite Chenin 2016 – Botrivier 495**

Free run juice ferment naturally, left on the lees for 12 months. Peachy apricot with hints of honey and spice on the nose, a rich mouth-filling entry with yellow peach, melon and spice. Good fruit balanced by clean citrus notes ends in a refreshing finish.

## SÉMILLON

**Boekenhoutskloof Sémillon 2016 – Franschhoek 580**

This wine has creamy white fruit on the nose, with hints of almond, spiced citrus and stone fruit. It shows an appealing freshness.

## CHARDONNAY

**Ataraxia Chardonnay 2013 – Hemel & Aarde Valley 750**

A chiselled, focussed wine that manages to be both subtle and intense. The palate is graceful and poised. A forceful mineral acidity is beautifully balanced by a subtle intensity of fruit.

**Hamilton Russell Chardonnay 2018 – Hemel & Aarde Valley 820**

A tight dry wine, with complex mineral character and length, balancing a rich palate. This wine is classically terroir driven with pear and lime aromas.

## VIOGNIER

**Wildevorst Viognier 2016 – Swartland 330**

Fermented in an old French oak barrel and matured on the lees for five months after. Beautiful aromas of orange blossom and pear with hints of stone fruit on the pallet.

**Creation Viognier 2016 – Walker Bay 370**

Abundantly fruity yet refined on the nose with fragrant white peach aromas mingling with a rich, creamy character. These follow onto the palate with minerality and well-integrated acidity.

## CINSAULT

**Cinsault Blanc 2017 – Wellington 495**

This wine made from the last remaining 0,2 hectares of old vines in the Cape was fermented partly on skins and aged for 10 months in locally produced clay amphorae. Only 1000 bottles produced.

## WHITE BLENDS

**Luddite Saboteur 2017 White – Botrivier 380**

A serious and well structured, yet refreshing wine. Dry conditions in 2017 resulted in smaller crops with greater concentration in flavour.

**Rall White 2012, 2015, 2017 – Coastal 495**

The fruit for this wine was meticulously sourced. Minimal cellar intervention allowed each component to develop naturally in older oak before blending, thus creating a handcrafted wine.

# THE REDS

## MERLOT

**Meerlust Merlot 2016 – Stellenbosch 785**

Deep purple in colour and a ruby rim. Expressive nose with plum and mulberry. A dense palate, bursting with ripe fruit and supported by a long aftertaste.

## PINOTAGE

**CT De Waal Pinotage 2015 – Stellenbosch 820**

A beautiful dark wine, flavours of prune and blackcurrant. Full-bodied and rich with a smooth lingering finish. A wine dedicated to the producer of the first Pinotage in 1941.

## CABERNET FRANC

**Rainbow's End Cabernet Franc 2017 – Stellenbosch 500**

Intense fruit and a juicy palate, layers of dark chocolate and a hint of coffee. Soft, fine tannins.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

**Stark Conde Cabernet 2015 – Stellenbosch 490**

Blackberry fruit with cedar notes. The palate is rich and polished with dark fruit and mocha flavours. Long finish with fine tannins, a very dry year resulted in a rich soft wine.

## RED BLENDS

**Rall Red 2012, 2013, 2014 – Swartland 495**

With fruit sourced from specific vineyards, for the best soil and slope, the wine is fermented naturally and aged in small French oak before blending. A wine that truly expresses its terroir.

# SPARKLING WINES

## MÉTHODE CAP CLASSIQUE

**Graham Beck Brut Rose NV – Robertson 420**

Whiffs of raspberries, cherries and minerality, delivering lively fine mousse with subtle red berry flavours. A flirtatious and fun wine, yet elegant and structured.

**Thelema Brut 2014 – Stellenbosch 490**

This bubbly is made in a fresh clean style, creamy citrus flavours, biscuits and good acidity.
