1 Anchorage
 Arrive in Anchorage, Alaska today! We will greet you upon arrival and escort you to your luxury accommodations for this evening. *Dinner*

2 Iditarod Dog Kennels & Denali National Park
 Board your luxury motor coach for a journey to the expansive landscapes of Denali National Park with multiple sightseeing stops along the Park's Highway! Visit an Iditarod dog kennel for a private presentation on dog mushing and a chance to interact with the pups. Then enjoy a visit to the Denali Visitor's Center before your overnight at the entrance to Denali National Park. Enjoy amazing Alaskan cuisine at 229 Parks tonight. *All Meals*

3 Denali National Park Touring
 Choose to take either the 92.5 mile trip deep into Denali National Park on board the Kantishna Wilderness Tour (10-12 hours) or join the shorter (8 hour) 62 mile Tundra Wilderness Tour today. Be on the lookout for bears, moose, caribou, wolves and Dall sheep. Return to the park entrance for the evening. *All Meals*

4 Talkeetna
 Join the first class cars of the Alaska Railroad for a scenic trip to Talkeetna. You will have time to explore Talkeetna with a quaint downtown that's classified as a National Historic Site, and with buildings dating from the early 1900s. *All Meals*

5 Anchorage, Kenai Peninsula & Seward
 Wake up to a breakfast at the historic Talkeetna Roadhouse where you can rub elbows with the locals. Return to Anchorage and enjoy lunch before a scenic journey to the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center. Here you can view bears, moose and other animals up close, while learning about efforts being made to preserve and protect Alaska's wildlife. Continue exploring the Kenai Peninsula on your way to Seward this evening. *All Meals*

6 Kenai Fjords National Park
 Today you will enjoy a 6 hour small boat cruise viewing the glaciers and marine wildlife of Kenai Fjords National Park. Have your camera ready to capture the majesty of the mighty Humpback and Orca whales that inhabit these waters during the summer months. Sea lions, otters, harbor seals, puffins and eagles also call this pristine environment home. After your small boat cruise, return to Anchorage for a farewell dinner before relaxing at The Lakefront, located on the banks of Lake Hood, the busiest sea plane base in the world! *All Meals*

7 Fly Home
 Transfer to the Anchorage airport and board flights bound for home. If you wish to extend your stay with further activities, we would be happy to help you make further arrangements. *Breakfast*
