Keep the shadow small and slightly downward pointing, but be aware of having your light source too high which will create odd shadows and cause loss of the catchlights. Use it appropriately. For reflections, try to be creative with the different types of reflective surfaces; sometimes, the best reflections are found in unexpected places like floors, glass, puddles, and granite walls.

Careful subject positioning was used to create a loop-lighting pattern in this ambient-light portrait. Loop light is probably the most common or popular lighting pattern as it is easy to create and

flatters most people. That quibble aside, this is a good chapter that beginners will definitely learn a lot from. If you need to shoot on a sunny day, be sure to move into the shade. Ambient light can be measured using an incident light meter and controlled using a combination of shutter speed and aperture. Notice how the light from the reflector illuminates the eyes and makes them sparkle. The individual sits facing the main light. In classical portraiture there are several things you need to control and think about to make a flattering portrait of your subjects, including: lighting ratio, lighting pattern, facial view, and angle of view. Unlike loop lighting where the shadow of the nose and cheek do not touch, in Rembrandt lighting they do meet which, creates that trapped little triangle of light in the middle. I suggest you get to know these basics inside out, and as with most things, then you can break the rules.
