- 1. ALL entry forms must be submitted by email or WhatsApp to reach the secretary prior to Show Day. Entry fee of 50p per class (children's classes under 16 free) to be paid on the day. Entries will be accepted on Show Day
- 2. Only one Exhibit per class is permitted
- 3. Exhibits must be made/grown by the Exhibitor
- 4. Each entry MUST be accompanied by a sealed envelope containing the exhibitor's name and address, which will be displayed with entry after judging. Junior Classes to also state age. The envelope is to be attached firmly to the exhibit
- 5. All Exhibits should be correctly and clearly named
- 6. All Exhibits should be staged between 10am 12noon at the site on Show Day
- 7. Exhibits should not be removed before 4.00pm from the Tent
- 8. All objections to be delivered in writing to the Secretary within one hour of the class being judged. Stewards shall, where applicable, deal with objections
- 9. Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for and shall make good and repair any loss, damage, or injury caused by their exhibit or themselves and shall indemnify and hold blameless the Raglan Festival against any legal or other proceedings in regard thereto
- 10. Prize Cards will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed entries
