

Laundry Procedure (HS2)

- All tea towels, hand towels, and bibs used for tamariki must be laundered in hot water using laundry detergent and replaced daily.
- All sheets and other bedding that has direct contact with the tamariki must be washed in hot water with laundry detergent at least weekly and when soiled.
- Blankets and other bedding that do not come into direct contact with the tamariki must be washed in hot water using laundry detergent at least monthly and when soiled.
- Blankets must be aired regularly.
- Dress up clothes and fabric play items must be washed at least weekly and when soiled in hot water with laundry detergent.
- Cloths used for art and messy play must be laundered after use in hot water and using laundry detergent.
- If the washing is done in the home of the educator, then it must be separate to the household wash. If desired an arrangement may be made with family/whānau to launder the linen.
- Different types of laundry are washed separately to avoid cross infection, e.g., Kitchen and bathroom linen is separated from bedding linen.
